

WEBDIZ 2010 – PROBLEM STATEMENTS

Participants need to choose one problem from the following problem statements

WEBSITE OF A TOURING ROCK BAND

“**Turing Hill**” is a rock band with a massive fan following, and is set to cover 3 cities on its 2 weeklong tour. However they have no online presence and it's up to *you* to change that!

The website you make must contain the following pages:

- Home
- News
- About (the band)
- Discography
- Gallery
- Tour details (dates and locations)

The band must consist of at least 3 members: 1 vocalist, 1 guitarist, and 1 drummer compulsory.

The discography must cover at least 2 albums.

The gallery must contain a decent number (>7) of pictures.

WEBSITE OF AN AUTOMOBILE COMPANY

“**Beagle**”, an international automobile company, needs publicity. It's your job to create a good looking website for them.

The website you make must contain the following pages:

- Home
- News and Company Events (parties, farewells, promotions, etc.)
- History
- Company presence (showroom locations, affiliated website, etc.)
- Gallery of automobiles (with relevant info)
- Careers at the company
- Contact

Mention at least 4 tidings/events on the “News and Company Events” page.

This is an *international* company. Showrooms must be numerous (>12), and must cover multiple Countries (>4).

There must be a minimum of 5 automobile models on display on the “Gallery” page.

The contact page must contain names and phone numbers of each of the showroom managers.

WEBSITE OF A MOVIE STAR

“**James Baloonney**”, the famous Hollywood actor wants a website of his own. Easy money here!

The website must contain the following pages:

- Home
- Biography
- Photo Gallery
- Filmography
- Upcoming Projects
- Mini Blog

The gallery must contain a decent number (>7) of pictures.

The “Filmography” page must cover at least 5 films, each accompanied by relevant details.

The actor must have at least 2 “upcoming projects”, both of which must be described.

The mini-blog must contain a couple of posts from the actor.

NOTES

1. Relevant information not mentioned here may be included in an appropriately titled web page.
2. All details required to complete the website must be invented.
